5. Events

• 2016 Calendar (Colin Walker)

New challenges and delays arising because Parks Victoria (PV) now require some permits to be signed off by Dja Dja Wurrung, which can add 4 weeks to the planning schedule. Rule changes mean that PV no longer issue permits locally - Dept of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) issues permits for their areas. Problems when the Melbourne office does not know where our maps are, eg Mandurang. Total lead time now up to 12 weeks, which is hard when we normally don't begin to plan maps and start locations for the year until the year has started.

Need dot-point summary of permit issues with PV and DELWP, to take up with the

department. Action: Colin Walker, Nigel McGuckian.

Maps owned by other clubs

We have a number of events this year on maps owned by other clubs, eg, Chewton (MFR), Kimbolton Nth, Eppalock (YV), Mt Alexander (TK). We need their permission to use. Check with Richard that this has been done. Action: Ben Goonan

Kooyoora weekend in June

Yarra Valley club (YV) organising Saturday event with courses to the west of the campground; Bendigo to organise Sunday event with courses on east side. Need organiser, course setter, controller, volunteers.

Need to email all club members to ask for above; and check why we have been bumped to Sunday, when our event is normally on the Saturday. Action: Julie Flynn

Sprint Champs, November. Wait until we are asked formally by OV to assist.

6. Communication

Come and Try Orienteering brochure produced at very short notice by Jacqui Gleeson, to be available at next few CATI events.

7. Mapping (Nigel McGuckian)

How do we plan for and purchase maps? Tender for quotes? List of providers? We need 2 to 3 independent people to draft a policy. Also need to include experienced mappers such as Neil Barr and Chris Creely for their encyclopaedic knowledge of current and future areas to map. Possible group of Nigel, Jim, Peter F, and Neil to plan strategy (areas and events) and policy.

Need existing list of requirements (tendering process, etc) and policies as starting point. Action: Nigel McGuckian, Louise Hall

8. Development

Space Racing (Nigel McGuckian)

Group of Jacqui Knee, Colin Walker, Peter Creely and Andrew Cameron to plan for this year's SR program. We should be encouraging teenagers to work for the club in organising events. Hard part is how to get the kids there - advertising, promoting, etc. Action: meet and report back

• Peta Whitford (OV) is looking for people to provide orienteering to primary schools through Australian Sports Commission funding.

9. Equipment and Facilities

Inventory of club assets

We need an itemised list of what the club actually owns, both in the trailer and scattered around people's homes. Start by emailing Peter Galvin for previous list. Action: Nigel McGuckian

Extra set of SI Controls

Requested by John Wilkinson, supported by Neil Barr. Discussion around how many units we currently have (see asset list above!). Colin and Jim believe that we have around 60 controls already, including the Space Racing set, which should be sufficient for consecutive events. Need to check stands and flags. Action: Jim Russell

Storage Shed

Positive discussions with Lincoln Fitzgerald from CoGB council regarding a 6m x 6m drive-through shed on council land, possibly at the Spring Gully toy library site (or possibly Mandurang). Council to provide lease of land at \$110/year, building permit, and power connection. Further meeting next month. Action: Julie Flynn, Nigel McGuckian

10. Other Business

- There is an OV workshop on Sunday 28 February on development and participation.
 Open to a Bendigo representative.
- As at 22 February, we have 76 paid up club members in Eventor, *cf* total of 125 in 2015.
- Alison asked about getting a club t-shirt. Need to contact supplier (Dirtyd in NZ), and consider a few different styles - existing design with zip, alternate design with crew neck.
