1. Governance (Julie Flynn, in absentia)

Meeting to talk about next year - 2017 - to be held at the Flynn residence on 1 May 2016, 3pm. Food will be provided. Please RSVP to Julie president@bendigo-orienteers.com.au

2. Secretary's report (Louise Hall)

- Sign-out sheet for equipment trailer? Several items went "missing" within days of each other, and the people who needed them didn't know where they were. A simple sign-out sheet may alleviate this. Once the equipment inventory is complete, we need *someone* to take charge in this area.
- First aid course we have a number of club members with expired First Aid certification. Need to contact provider for quote (Safety Systems is a client of mine, and runs FA courses). Action: Louise Hall
- Email received from OWLs (Orienteers Who Lunch) advising that the next lunch will be on 12 April 2016, from 12pm, at Gisborne Peak Winery. Anyone who is interested, please contact Diane and Peter Searle.
- Eventor improvements event fees are now linked to membership, meaning that the "members discount" should happen automatically.
- Black Crow two nominations have been received from Peter Creely. Raised suggestion that these be added to a Black Crow page on the website, so they are available all year (rather than for 5 minutes before the annual presentations). Action: Louise Hall

3. Treasurer's report (Andrew Wallace)

Andrew presented the General Ledger and Balance Sheet for the calendar month of February. There was some discussion regarding payment of legal fees for GoExploreIt - these will be fully detailed in the GEI project report (to come).

4. Events

Event calendar mostly finalised, with approvals through for most events. Dja Dja Warrung have advised that access to White Hills, Kooyoora, and Korong would be severely restricted. Nigel met with Rodney Carter, CEO, to explain orienteering (ie, staying on tracks is not going to happen). Some areas will need to be managed differently to what has been done in the past. There may be a fee for service for a Welcome to Country. Jim has talked to Alex and YVV so they are aware of issues.

Need to (a) formally advise YVV of the above, and (b) get back to Dja Dja Warrung to understand the sensitive areas that we need to keep out of. Action: Nigel McGuckian

We urgently need course setter for 9 April event at Kangaroo Gully, or the event may be cancelled.

Kooyoora event - need course setter and controller. Nigel tentatively volunteered to be organiser.

Email from Ben Goonan:

- Maps owned by Yarra Valley will cost \$40.00 per event. This is a single fee for the use of the map for the event
- Maps owned by Tuckonie will be charged at \$0.50/per competitor
- There are no other fees/costs associated with these events or with use of other maps for these
 events.

5. Space Racing (Peter Creely)

Skeleton calendar in place, starting 12 April 2016 at Kangaroo Flat gardens. First series events to run on Tuesday afternoons, 4pm-5pm. Second series will run on Saturdays, third series TBD.

Need to treat Space Racing as a serious sport, and not just a run around a park. Paid help from current juniors? Big Picture considerations - what comes after SR? Progression into bush orienteering.

6. Mapping

Mapping group of Jim Russell, Chris Creely, Neil Barr, Peter Forbes to meet 22 March 2016.

Discussion around possible conflict of interest where a couple of club members own high-quality printers, and whether they should be the club's preferred (or required) suppliers for map printing. Consensus was that course setters are free to choose whatever printing service they like, and the committee approves the use of its own members for this purpose.

7. Park Street Challenge (Andrew Cameron)

Funded from a grant from the Australian Government, PSC information has mostly spread by Facebook (https://www.facebook.com/pschal), and a leaflet titled "Nature Deficit Disorder", with a website build in progress. There is no orienteering language used, and the initial feeling was that they didn't want a lot of orienteers running around being intimidating.

The aim is to get kids "less obese". Need to identify a pathway from PSC. Is it Space Racing? Or vice versa.

Events have been run at local lakes (Kennington, Weeroona, Neangar) on Sundays at 5pm. Three more events are planned for April.

Heather raised the issue of sourcing local people to build a website. Craig had spent some time looking at different providers, however there was no one available locally with sufficient knowledge of metrics we need to measure

Sold the GoExploreIt name for \$4000 profit, may piggyback the event structure on PSC. Waiting for website/testing.

8. Equipment and Facilities

SportIdent controls (Colin Walker)

Quote received from SportIdent via Colin to purchase a further 20 SI controls, at approx AU\$4750. Discussion about what we need the extra controls for. We have 60 SI controls at the moment, and one event rarely uses more than 30, so even a double-header is covered. However, we have one major event coming up which will need 80 controls.

Jim argued that the extra set would be primarily for school's use, essentially a second Space Racing set (minus the metal plates).

Quote accepted, with a query against the extra printer/download box which is not required. Moved: Nigel McGuckian, seconded Jim Russell

Storage Shed (Nigel McGuckian)

Need a decision on the amount that the club is prepared to contribute to "our" shed. Wish list:

double car sized shed drive-through - no backing trailer shelves build ourselves (if cheaper) shed on public land, lease ¬\$100/yr

Skills inventory (Alison Radford)

Some information has been collected from Peta Whitford, but a lot of it is out of date, eg WWC expiry dates. Suggested that she put the spreadsheet on the website so people can update their own information. (Secretary's note: I have some notifications of updated expiry dates. Will get these to Alison)

9. Communication (Louise Hall)

- Louise presented a social media outline showing integration (or lack of) between the website, Facebook, Team App, Space Racing, with the points discussed:
 - O Orienteering WA website (http://www.wa.orienteering.asn.au/) has an eventor link on the front page, showing a very cut-down list of coming events. Do we want this too? Approximate cost 1-3 hours, ie. < \$500. Emphatic yes. Moved: Louise Hall, seconded: Jim Russell
 - O How do people find out about the next event? Generally seems to be Eventor or Team App. What about Facebook Events, similar to PSC?
- Andrew Wallace raised the issue of incomplete information on our coming events in Eventor. Jim pointed out that it is up to each course setter to update this information as part of the course setting process. He only put the basic outline in the calendar as a placeholder. Need to find someone else to manage this process. Action: Jim Russell.
