- The Granites. 50 minutes from Bendigo through Serpentine and Borung. Assessed by Alex Tarr in his old terrain report as international standard terrain.

- Anderson's Diggings. a few k south east of Dunnolly. A modest area of complex mining terrain that, again, Alex Tarr assessed as world class. This is extended with spur gully terrain and some more scattered mining. Notable also in that a photo from this area has featured on the club web site home page for years and now on the newsletter.

- The area surrounding Tarnagulla. Really nice open terrain with some unique dredge hollow terrain along Sandy Creek.
