# • Review of recent events

- June 29 Mandurang Score event
- A cold wet day for this event. Prue organized for hot soup and Clare brought some brownie slice. These encouraged people o stay around the event centre and socialize despite the weather.

- The club's old gas stove leaked and has lost adjustment of the flame on one burner. This was abandoned because of safety issues and club members had a couple of small single burner propane stoves. Neil has advised it would be safest for the club to replace our old stove with a small propane model and committee supported this. ACTION: Neil to purchase a new stove (moved by John, seconded by Nola)
- Ted and Neil had difficulty getting the OE score software to work. Neil couldn't get SI Droid to work because of poorly connecting equipment. A motion was moved by Julie to purchase an OE12 score software package, but there was no seconder for this. The next score event in is early August at Fiddlers Green. It was suggested that SI Droid could be used with a USBC-USBA OTG connecter, but Neil is recommending that MEos be used instead.

Kooyoora Event - September 7

Daryl Fleay will set the courses and put out controls but will not be there on the day. Ross suggested we contact Chris Naunton to run the event on the day.

ACTION: Ross to follow up with Toph.

 Safety Procedures - After having a member late back during the wet and cold event at Mandurang, a recommendation was made to collect more information from participants (phone numbers, whether they are taking their phones and car registration numbers). This is not a new issue and organisers already collect this information for many other clubs' events. The committee supported this suggestion. ACTION: this is to become standard practice for Bendigo events.

- Victorian Long Distance Championships 2025, Mt Korong. This is being considered for the Sunday of Anzac Day long weekend in 2025, which is also the weekend following Easter. Neil has offered to set courses and Ted has offered to control this. Margi will ask the Dandenong Ranges OC if they could work with Bendigo to jointly organize the event. There was general support among the committee for this, but some concern that we could be overcommitting ourselves. ACTION: Margi to follow up with DROC committee.
- Neil wants to run an OE training day for members. Jim and Neil will work together on this, as Jim has offered to do this in the past. ACTION: Organise this after Jim returns from Europe on 20 July.
- Ross noticed Eureka has added a couple of events that have been re-scheduled and now clash with Bendigo events. ACTION: Ross offered to contact Wendy Tavener who is coordinating the OV calendar while Laurie Niven is away.
- Jim suggested we advertise the committee meeting dates in the newsletter with advise to contact the secretary if members want to attend. Ross will set up Google online meetings a week in advance for those who cannot attend in person.
