
Jim qualified overall in 3rd place, winning his first race and coming third in the second.

Junior Development Fund

I would like to let people know that I will be putting a proposal to the club at the next meeting (August) to establish a fund to assist with the development of the sub juniors we have now, and those who will be attracted to orienteering in the future.

The J Squad. At present there are about 20 kids who come out regularly to our Bush-O events; just under half of these are in the 8 to 10 years old bracket and have come mainly from Space Racing. This age group is a lot younger than the sport usually deals with as a squad - indeed younger than Bendigo has ever had to cater for, and because of that I feel the situation needs special treatment. In most cases, our present Victorian elite juniors were born into orienteering families, they attend their first events in prams and pushers and are doing string courses as toddlers long before they move into M/W10 and onwards; they have a long history and very solid family support in orienteering. Compare that to our kids, they come to us at age 8, 9, 10, their first experience of orienteering, in most cases, is Space Racing; their families maybe have heard of orienteering but almost none have actually experienced it up until now. They are really newcomers in every sense of the word!

So why not spend some money on setting up a support program that will help the kids - surely we can afford it! Anyway, if done properly it won't cost much and we can look at it as a financial investment, although priority must be given to the kid's personal development and keeping faith with their orienteering expectations, rather than run the risk of looking at them purely as 'financial investment' opportunities.

Maybe there's not a lot of interest in the promotion of orienteering generally, but I feel that we need to support these kids. At this stage of their development they are much more interested in getting around their course without too many errors than they are in reaching elite levels, but the enthusiasm is there, as is the potential. Surely, as a club we have an obligation to help develop that potential. Sadly, to date I see the enthusiasm of the kids to do better seemingly far outreaches our enthusiasm as a club to support them
