

Saturday October 21 - Twilight score event - Pilchers Bridge

The twilight event is a score event - get as many controls as you can in the time. All controls are worth 10 points. 10 point deduction for every part minute you are over your time. 1 hour, 2 hour and 3 hour events offered. Briefing at 6:00pm. Mass start at 6:15pm. Sunset is 7:45pm and darkness occurs at 8:10pm so a torch is required for 2 hour and 3 hour events.

The 1 hour event will be completed in daylight and there will be moderate navigation controls accessible in 1 hour. If you haven't done a score event before the 1 hour event would be a good introduction. Course Setter: Ross Slater.
