

April in Review and in Prospect by Neil Barr, President.

The first days of April marked the conclusion of the Australian Easter Three Day event near Murray Bridge in South Australia. The most notable feature of the carnival was unfortunately the unseasonably hot weather, with temperature maximums of 35 and 37 on Saturday and Sunday. There were a dozen entrants from our club. Most notable results were Thea Richardson 3rd in W21Sport, and a slew of fourths and fifths in age classes – Dianne and Petter Searle, Tony Radford and Ilka Barr. The rest of us did our best in oppressive conditions, but clearly the heat had an impact on logical thinking. Next year Easter orienteering is to the west of Bendigo, and three weeks later which means a high probability of more amenable weather.

John Wilkinson's event on Dead Bullock Gully went off well with 55 attendees, including four from Hong Kong. Does that make it an international event? It was clear that the open forests of Bendigo were to the Hong Kongers liking, which is no surprise given that 95% of most Hong Kong maps are deeper shades of green. What was not to the liking of one of them was a close encounter with a Golden Orb spider. Perhaps we need to warn international visitors in future...

Last weekend we left a break in our local fixture to make room for a rogaine down at Enfield south of Ballarat. Five club members competed, as well as half a dozen other regular faces at Bendigo events. Notable results were a second in the open Mixed category by a team that included Clare Brownridge, Derek Morris coming second in the UltraVets category and the club committee team of Julie and Neil winning the Mixed UltraVets. There will be another rogaine next month, closer to home.

Coming up we have an event on One Tree Hill looming this coming weekend. I expect some long legs given the course setters penchant for minimal control numbers. This is quickly followed by an Anzac Day Come and Try It event on Danger Hill, California Gully. Volunteer coaches are needed please. Contact Julie Flynn.

The following two weeks you can get your orienteering fix on Sunday events at Petticoat Gully near Creswick, and the following Sunday closer to home at Eppalock. The Bendigo Series then resumes on the 11th of May with an event on Sedgwick North. This new style of orienteering fixture will be reviewed towards the end of the year as part of designing the 2025 fixture. Factors we will be balancing are the impact on attendance by local orienteers, the extent of volunteer support and whether our events or other clubs' events impact attendance at each other's events.
